Plans are in place for the Legacy Park ribbon cutting and dedication of Gibbs Plaza next week, Thursday, October 27 at 11 a.m.

The 2016 Chip Seal Program was completed this week. Traffic striping is now being installed.

Replacement of the sidewalks at the Community Center is ongoing. Work on the

north side of the building and the missing sections of sidewalk on the east side of Beverly has been poured. Work on east side of the building started this week, and the crews will finish with the south sidewalks and the west end of the building in the next weeks.

Mission Police Officers responded to the following locations for emergency calls for service:


