Law Enforcement

Mission Police Officers responded to the following locations for emergency calls for service:


Criminal Threat	5700 Block of Woodson

Officers issued **1** Parking Violations and **75** Traffic Violations. There were **57** reports taken, and of those, **16** were arrested, including **3** DUI arrest and 1 drug arrest. Officers responded to **195** calls for service. Officers responded to **2** commercial alarms and **2** residential alarms.

During the week of 12/01/2016 to 12/07/2016 the Investigations Division assigned 4 cases to Detectives for investigation.

- Sergeant Palmieri is investigating three Domestic Violence related cases.
- Detective Davis is investigating an Aggravated Assault, two Auto Burglaries, and completed the criminal investigation related to the fatality car crash that occurred in August.
- Detective Bieberbach is investigating an Identity Theft and three Theft cases.

The investigations division has 75 open investigations and completed 9 supplements this period.


