ACTION ITEMS

1. Naming of Park at Mission Crossing - Laura Smith ([p. 3](#))

As a part of the Redevelopment Agreement with Mission Commons Investors, LLC, the southwest corner of the Mission Crossing development was donated to the City to become a public park. Over the last several years, there have been a number of discussions surrounding the selection of a name for the new park. The Council is now being asked to consider and approve the name "Legacy Park" and designate the central gathering area as "Gibbs Plaza."

2. Contract with GBA for Miscellaneous Drainage Projects - John Belger ([p. 8](#))

Due to significant amounts of rainfall this year, a number of stormwater infrastructure failures have occurred. Sinkholes have formed adjacent to these failures causing unsafe conditions for the public. The stormwater failures occurred at: 6500 W. 51st Street, 5303 Foxridge, and 5820 W. 61st Terrace. A task order has been developed by the City's engineers GBA and presented for Council consideration. The scope and fees includes surveying, site investigation, and development of plans for repairs. Project administration and bid phase services are included in the proposal in lump-sum amounts. Staff is seeking Council authorization in an amount not to exceed \$32,934.

3. Contract for Sidewalk Replacement at Sylvester Powell, Jr. Community Center - John Belger ([p. 14](#))

Replacement of deteriorated curbs and sidewalks and installation of ADA improvements surrounding the Community Center was budgeted in the 2016 Community Investment Program (CIP) for Parks and Recreation. The project was designed by Olsson Associates and competitively bid, with the City receiving seven (7) responses. Staff is seeking authorization to execute a contract with Tenoch Construction, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$139,600.45.
