RE: In-Office Massage Therapy Permit

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the In Office Massage Therapy Permit for Karen Diaz, upon final approval by the Chief of Police pending background check results.

DETAILS: Under the provisions of Mission’s Municipal Code, Chapter 620, anyone wanting to provide “In Office” massage therapy (chair massage) is required to submit an initial application which is considered by the City Council. Ms. Diaz has submitted her application / documentation regarding education and training, and her background check is currently underway. It is anticipated that her background check will be complete prior to the City Council Meeting, and a permit will not be issued until Chief Hadley has reviewed the background check and signed off on the application.

Following the initial application, massage therapist licenses are renewed administratively on an annual basis. The therapist must provide documentation of ongoing continuing education / training and remit the annual license fee.
