K.U. Urban Planning Implementation Class Presentation and Discussion: Johnson Drive street reconstruction design ideas

A class of students at K.U.'s Urban Planning Department has adopted the future Johnson Drive street project between Lamar Avenue and Metcalf Avenue as a study for their spring semester. They have met with City staff and have gathered data for the East Gateway District. They are evaluating business activity in the area, traffic and parking patterns, adjacent uses, and demographic data. They are evaluating the City's existing vision documents, and will be presenting the City with a guidebook for the project's street design at the end of the semester.

While at the meeting, the students discussed the area with the CIP Committee members and staff members present. They asked a variety of questions about the uses and character of the subject area. The students will incorporate the feedback into their final report.

Vice Chair Nichols expressed an interest in hearing a follow-up from the students at the conclusion of their project.
