- Park Benches with arms to assist with patrons and discourage skateboarders;
- Build benches with shade structures as many as possible;
- The group will liked the recycled plastic;
- Midcentury look straight line;
- Blend in with nature;
- Rockport page 132 in catalog like shape and colors;
- Bike racks;
- Doggie bags;
- Trash and recycle receptacles page 165 different colors;
- Drinking fountains with pet dish;
- Page 137 OR 144 Yorktown;
- Develop our identity;
- Matching benches and trash receptacles;
- Adopt a bench program;
- Picnic tables;
- BBQ Pits;
- Surface mount or in ground mount benches available in ground mount screws are not above the ground;
- Christy will put the list together;
- Please read the article that Christy put out at the last meeting and then look at the book that was given out;
- Will build on this list at the next meeting;
- Christy will email the article to everyone again.
