

# Mission Parks, Recreation and Tree Commission Meeting Minutes

## Approval of June 19, 2017 Meeting Minutes

The following changes were asked to be made to the minutes:

- Mary and Mellissa were listed twice;
- Approval of minutes were out 3 corrections not 3 correct;
- Add Beth Garcia as in attendance at the meeting.

Anne O'Leary moved to approve the minutes with the changes; Mellissa Currie seconded; Motion passed.

#### **Dog Park Task Force Recommendation**

- Members were asked to look over the recommendation before the meeting. They spoke with friends and neighbors and came back with the following comments:
- People were surprised at the cost;
- People would like to see the money used to upgrade our existing parks;
- Do not take any space from our existing parks to use as a dog park;
- People want the dog park, they know it is needed, but they realize that we do not have the land in Mission:
- Patrons value what we have, but also value dog owners, so it is a difficult decision;
- Master Plan stressed that we do not have enough park space as it is for the population that we have;

- Further discussion ensued.:
- Christy will send out a draft of the recommendation to members and she needs it back by Wednesday, July 26<sup>th</sup>. Reply to Christy only need not to reply all.
- **Karin Capron** moved to approve the recommendation of the Dog Park Task Force adding that existing parks and recreation funding not be used in the procurement or creation of a dog park.

- Motion passed.

### **Adopt a Park Program**

- Mellissa Currie, David Schwenk and Nate Dormer collaborated to put the Adopt A –
   Park Program information together for the commission;
- Commission Members were asked to read over the information;
- Discussion among members came back with the following recommendations for changes:
- Have a list of what the City would provide. City of Mission will provide consumable materials – Item #3 page 2;
- Discuss how the program would be promoted to the public i.e Mission Magazine, City
  of Mission Newsletter, Website and Mission businesses;
- Put together a flier to make available to Civic organizations;
- Put in Parks & Recreation Activity Guide, City of Mission Facebook and to Scout Programs;
- Under Who can adopt a park Bullet Point, Youth groups ADD ages 10 and older;
- Schools ADD ages 10 and older;
- Change Senior Citizens to Senior Groups;
- David Schwenk moved to approve the Adopt A Park program with the mentioned changes/additions and forward the to the City of Mission Community Development Committee for their approval;
- Mellissa Currie seconded;
- Motion passed.

#### Championship Tree Program

- Members were asked to choose one of the two fliers provided to them and and then critique that flier;
- Members chose the flier of a tree being hugged with the following suggestions:
- Make the tree smaller and place the person hugging the tree on the side instead of behind:
- Keep the girl on the tree swing for inside but make the picture smaller;
- Change the word *designed* to *designated* in the first paragraph;
- Change City Park of Mission to Mission City Park and add a space before the word commercial.
- Change the word *Council* to *City Council*;

- Bullet point 6 change the word a to my;
- Bullet point 13 change to **Survivor of construction**;
- Go with a softer green line in the bullets;
- Make clear looking leaves on the nomination form;
- Change the font on the front.

#### Other business:

- Jacque Gameson requested that a bid of the evaluations of the City of Mission trees still be accomplished this year;
- **Jacque Gameson** requested that the City of Mission work with KDOT on the removable of a dead tree in Countryside;
- Karin Capron donated two Rose of Sharon bushes for anyone to plant.
