I. Welcome and Introductions

Vice-Chair Andy Hyland welcomed everyone to the meeting, including Ingrid Worth, who, along with Stuti Dalal, was appointed to the Commission at the September City Council meeting. Emily Randel distributed an updated roster.

II. Approval of the September 11, 2017 minutes

Terri Baugh moved to approve the minutes. Sean Partain seconded the motion. The group approved the minutes with the change of the October meeting time to 6:00 p.m. instead of 6:30 p.m..

III. Communities for All Ages Discussion

At the September meeting, Emily Randel reviewed that she will be submitting an application on November 1 for the next level (Gold) of recognition for the Mid-America Regional Council's Communities for All Ages (CFAA). The Sustainability Commission had previously gone through the CFAA checklist in a series of meetings two years ago. The group had decided to go through the checklist and identify a few goals that seemed particularly important or timely for improvement. A summary of the discussion is included as an attachment.

I. Battery recycling update

Emily shared the battery recycling tracking sheet. Since February 2016, the program has turned in 730 pounds of batteries for recycling and spent \$1,267 on 22 battery boxes and one drop off at a local recycling business.
