- III. Sustainability Moment
 - Trent participated in the Celebration Tree Program as part of his announcement he is moving out of the City and resigning his City Council seat. He is sponsoring a pawpaw tree in Anderson Park.
 - Ramsey also announced he and his family are also moving out of the City and so he will be leaving his post on the Sustainability Commission as well.
 - Josh announced he and his wife completed the Treekeepers program through the PCC. As part of that program, they planted a new tree at PCC and are available to volunteer at future events with Bridging the Gap.
